F O R E W O R D

The objectives of our Federation include conducting studies in agriculture & rural credit, review and publish important documents/monographs on various aspects pertaining to short term cooperative credit institutions and also disseminate the same. Our Federation has been making sincere efforts in this direction and published so far 380 such documents on variety of issues. In addition to these publications, our Federation on a regular basis has been bringing out annual publications of the Basic Data on Performance of State Cooperative Banks, District Central Cooperative Banks and Primary Agricultural Credit Societies separately and a few analytical occasional papers on selected performance parameters. An attempt has also been made earlier to bring out fifteen publications on the data pertaining to Primary Agricultural Credit Societies (PACS).

There is an increasing demand for a publication dealing with state wise performance parameters of PACS. Therefore, our Federation attempted to bring out the current publication entitled "Performance of Primary Agricultural Credit Societies" by incorporating about 119 performance indicators - a detailed and improved version of earlier publications on PACS.

We are able to bring out the current publication well on time entirely due to the Cooperation of State Cooperative Banks, District Central Cooperative Banks and also the Registrar of Cooperative Societies. We are very much thankful to them.

We appreciate the sincere efforts of Shri R. H. Singh, Assistant Director in the Federation in the compilation of the data. We are also able to incorporate the graphical presentation of performance of the PACS entirely due to efforts of Shri Singh.

We hope that the publication will be useful for further analysis and to work out development action plans. We do further hope that the Apex Banks/DCCBs will attempt to develop profile of the PACS in respective states to help them to formulate concrete action plans to ensure their viability.

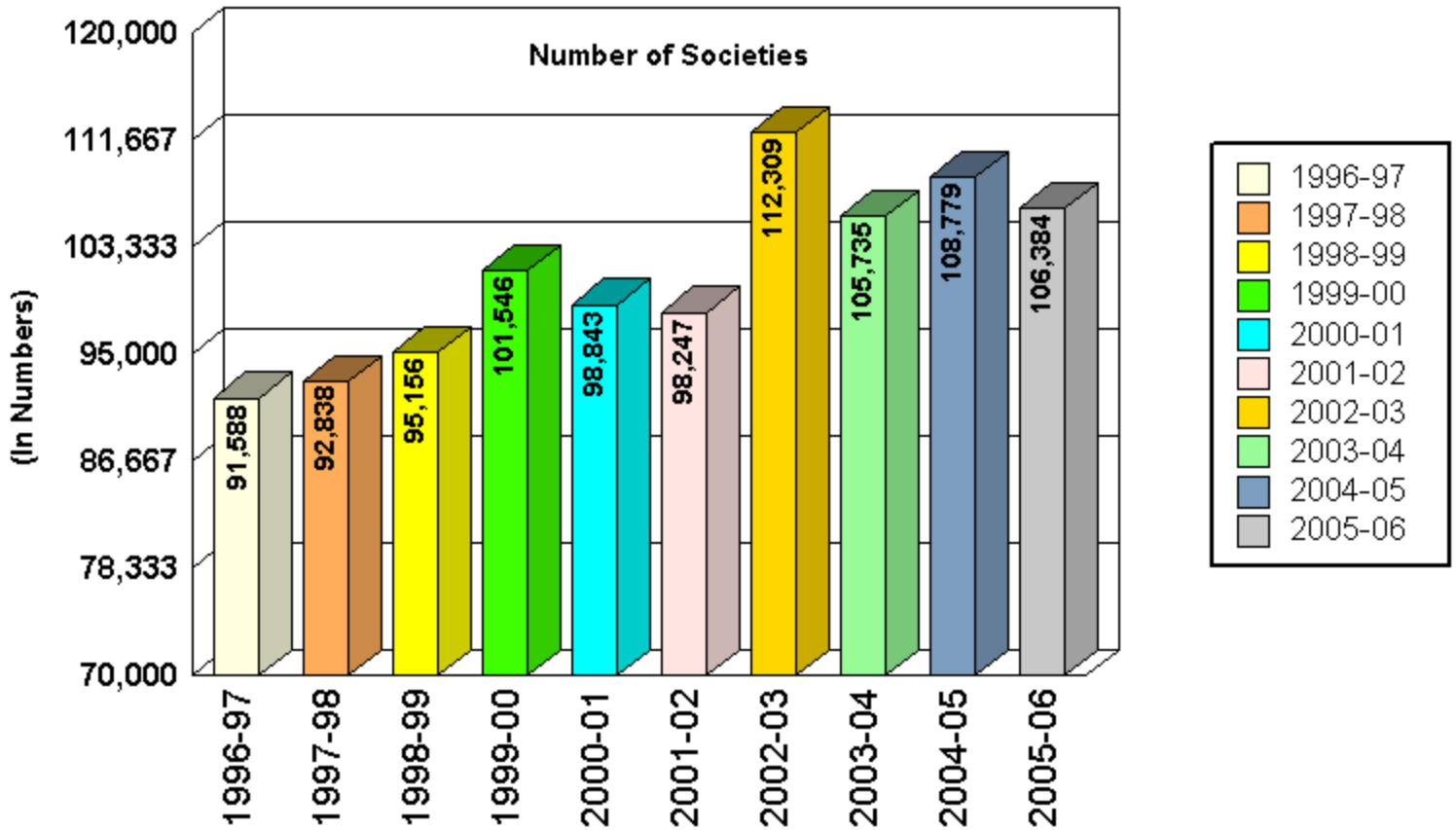

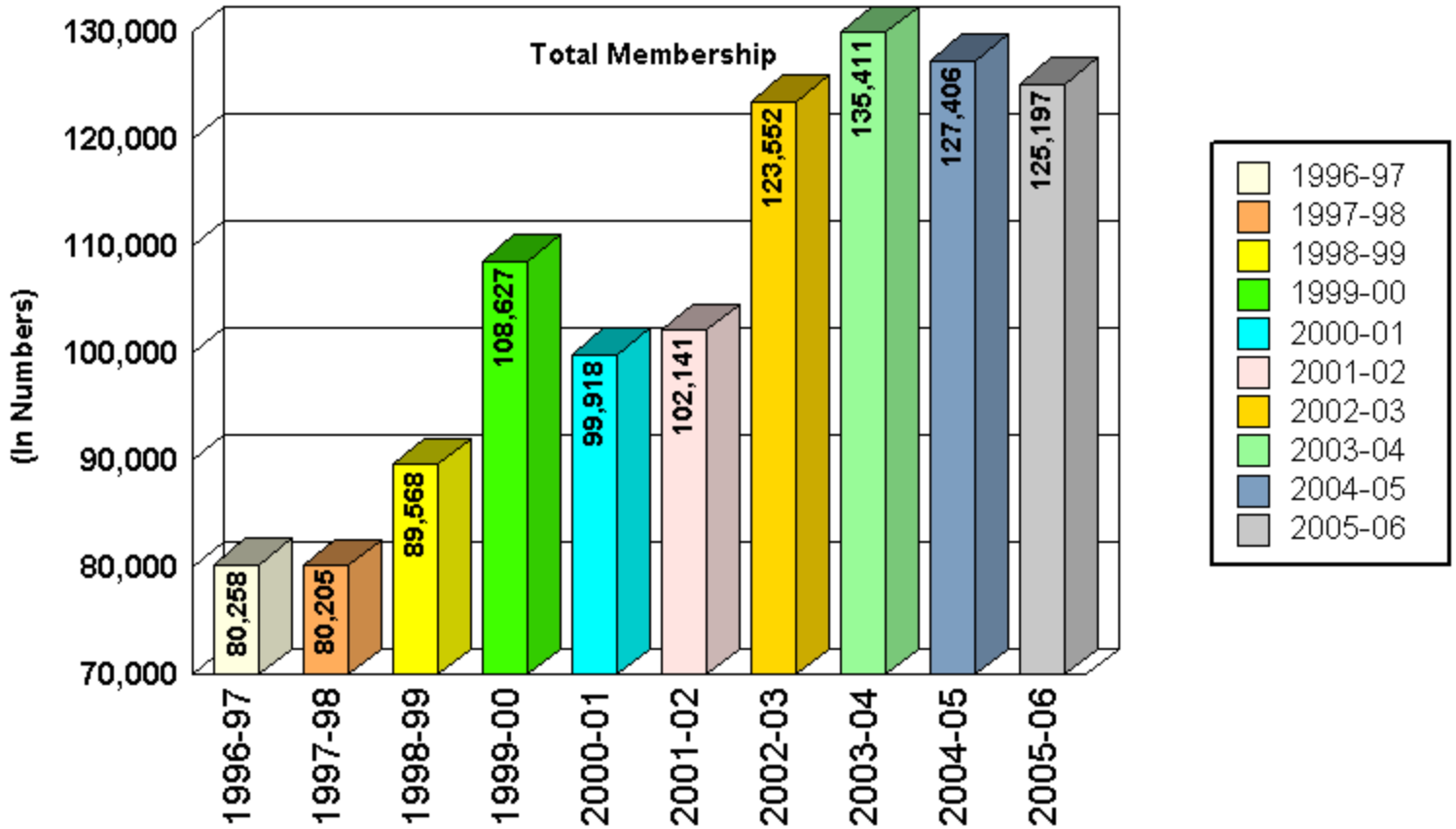
PERFORMANCE OF PRIMARY AGRICULTURAL CREDIT SOCIETIES OVER A DECADE

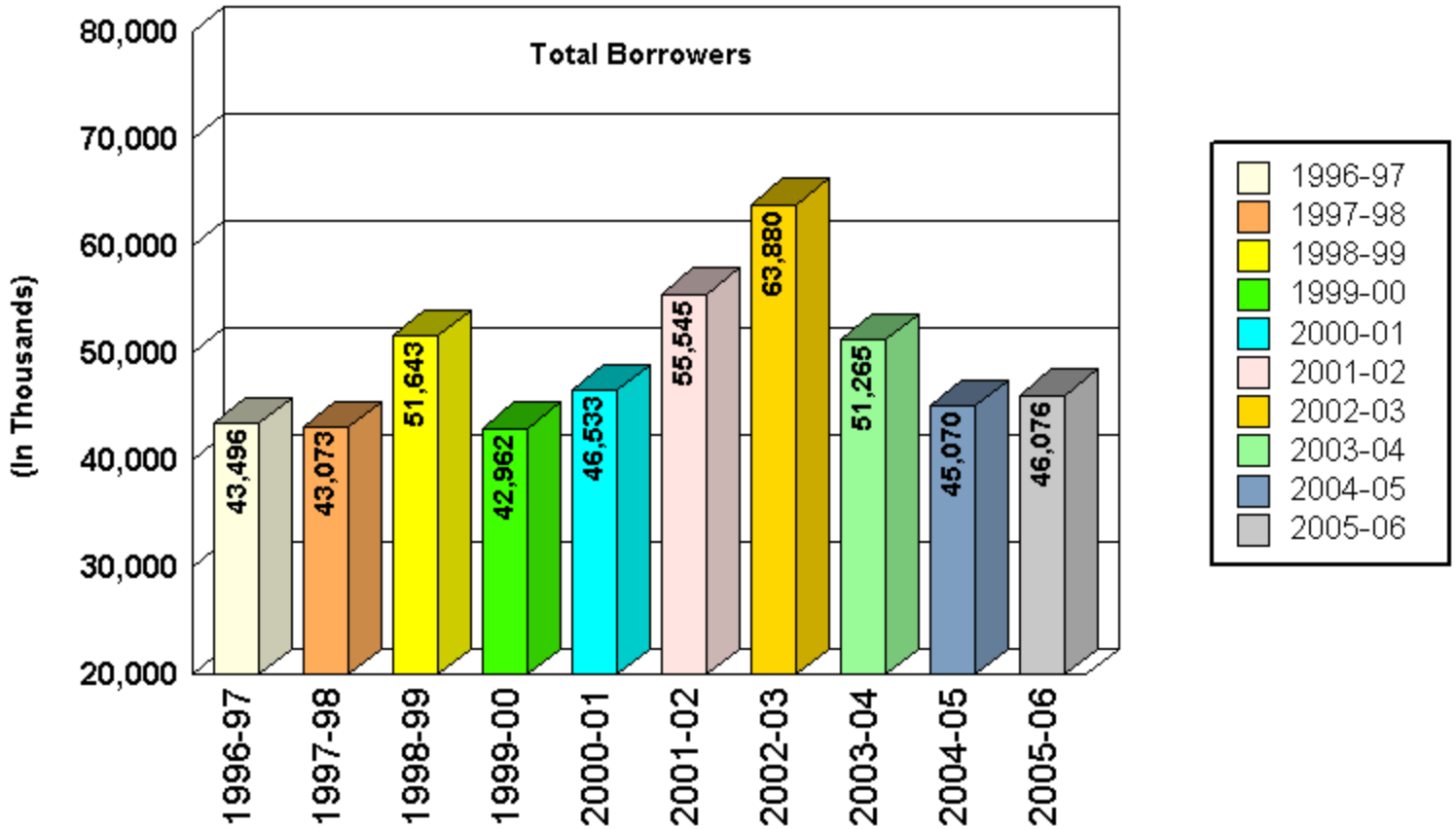

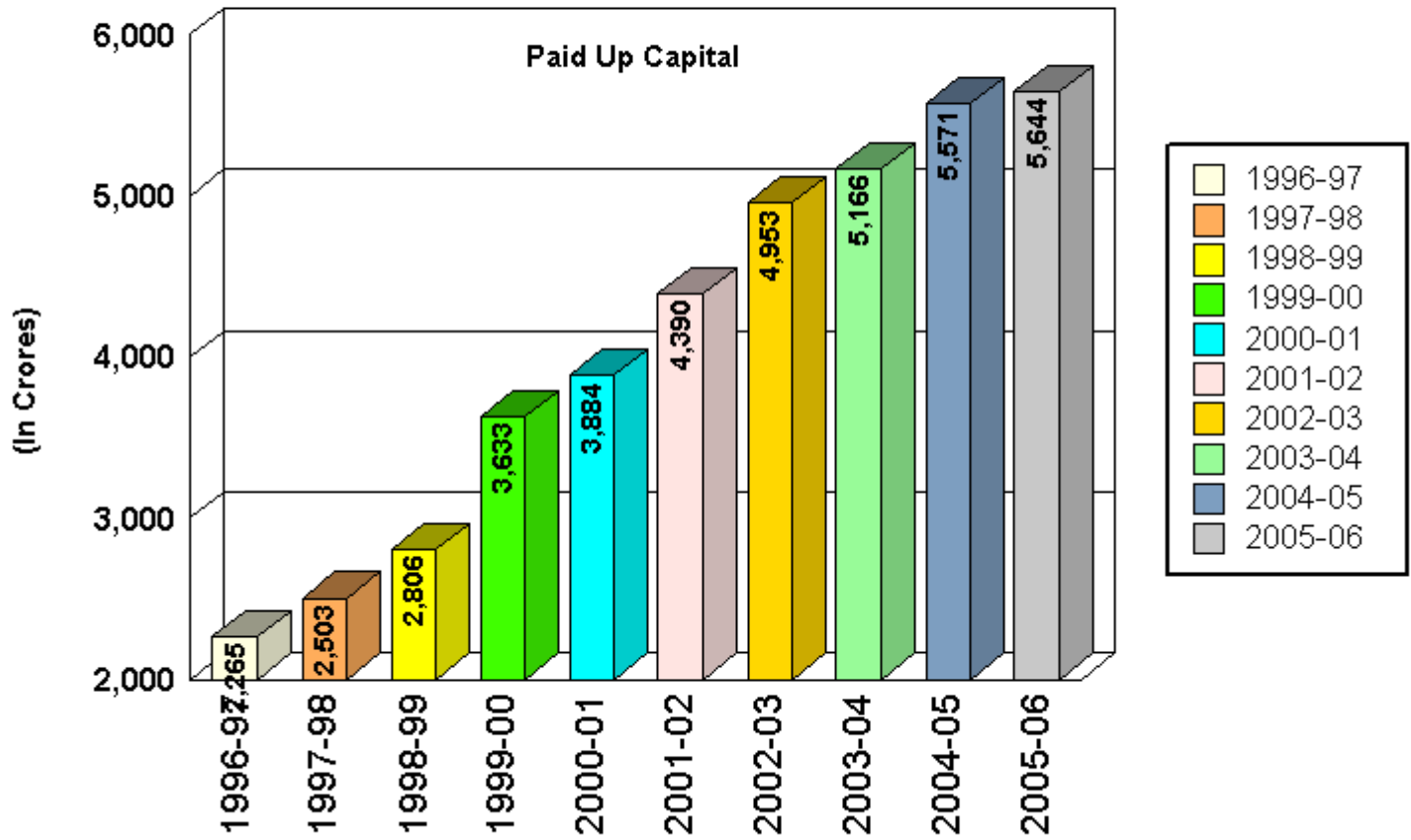
PERFORMANCE OF PRIMARY AGRICULTURAL CREDIT SOCIETIES OVER A DECADE

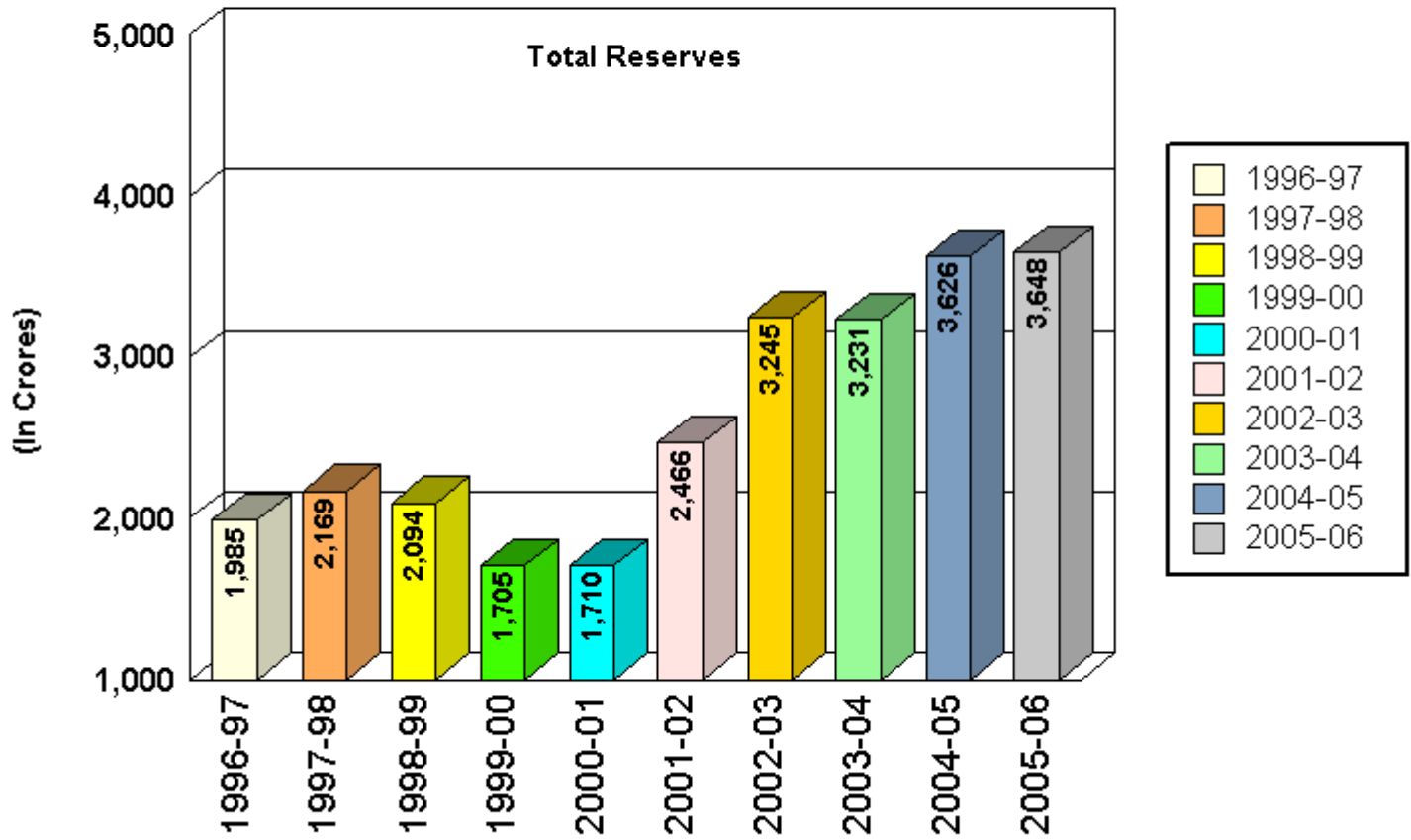

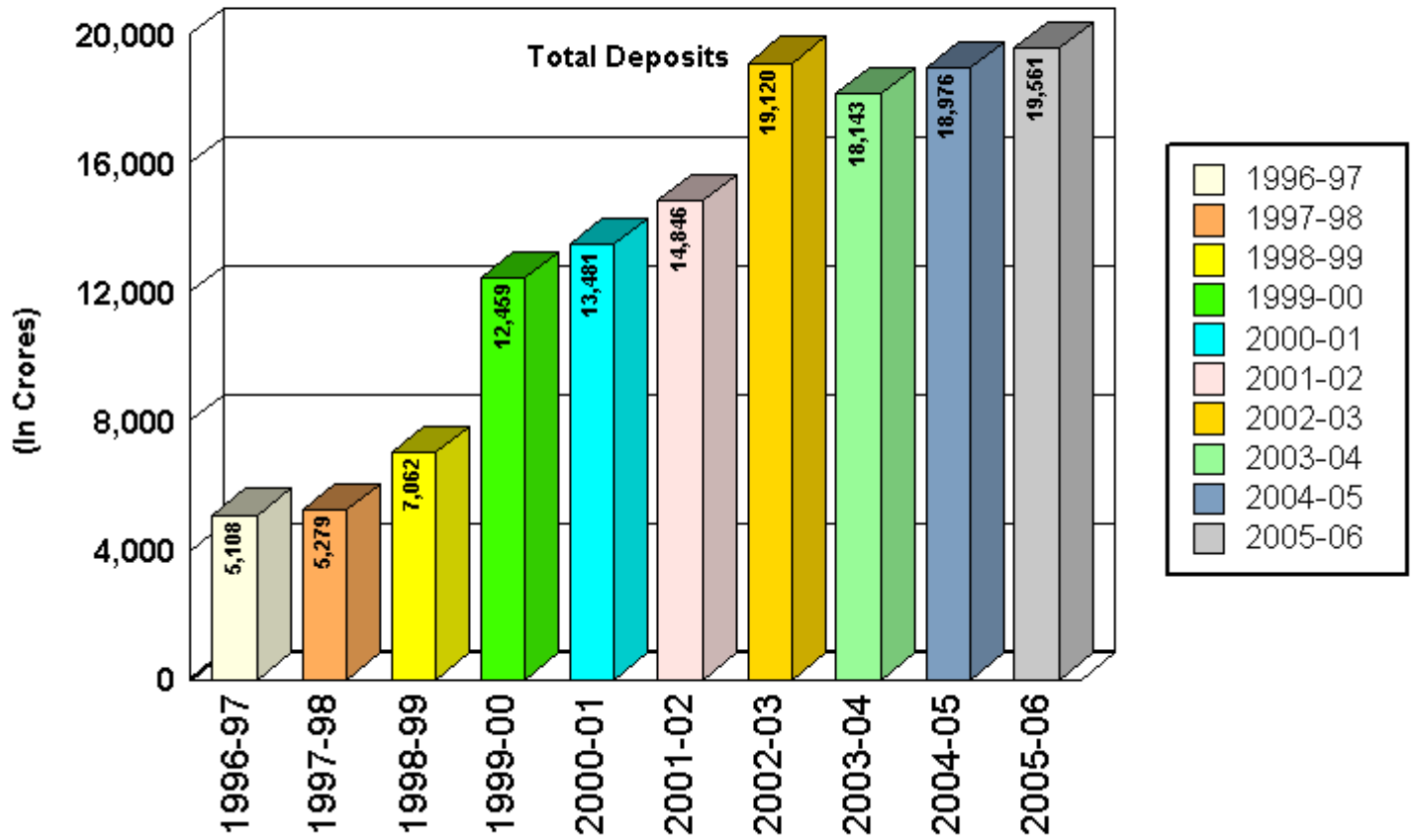
PERFORMANCE OF PRIMARY AGRICULTURAL CREDIT SOCIETIES OVER A DECADE

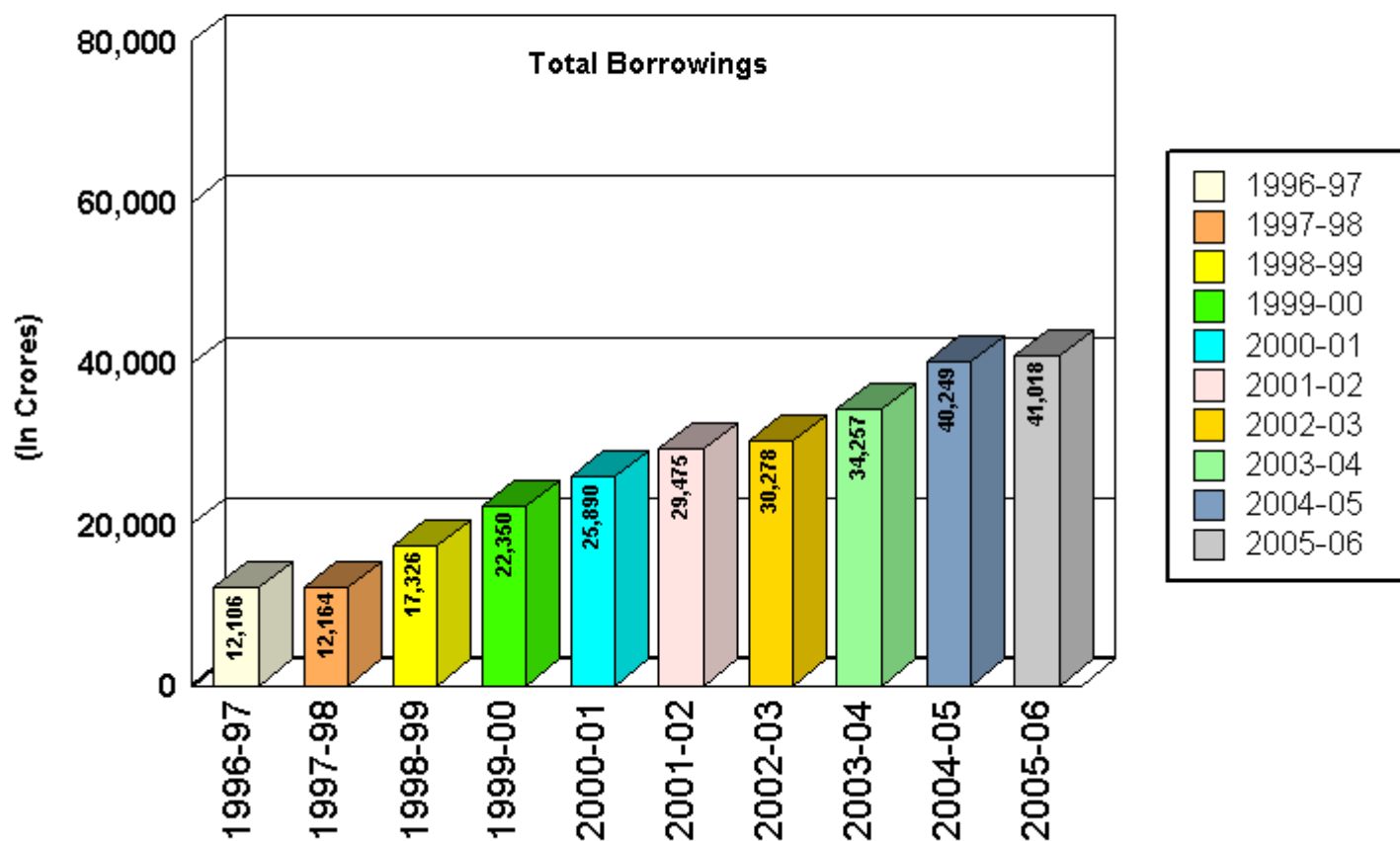
PERFORMANCE OF PRIMARY AGRICULTURAL CREDIT SOCIETIES OVER A DECADE

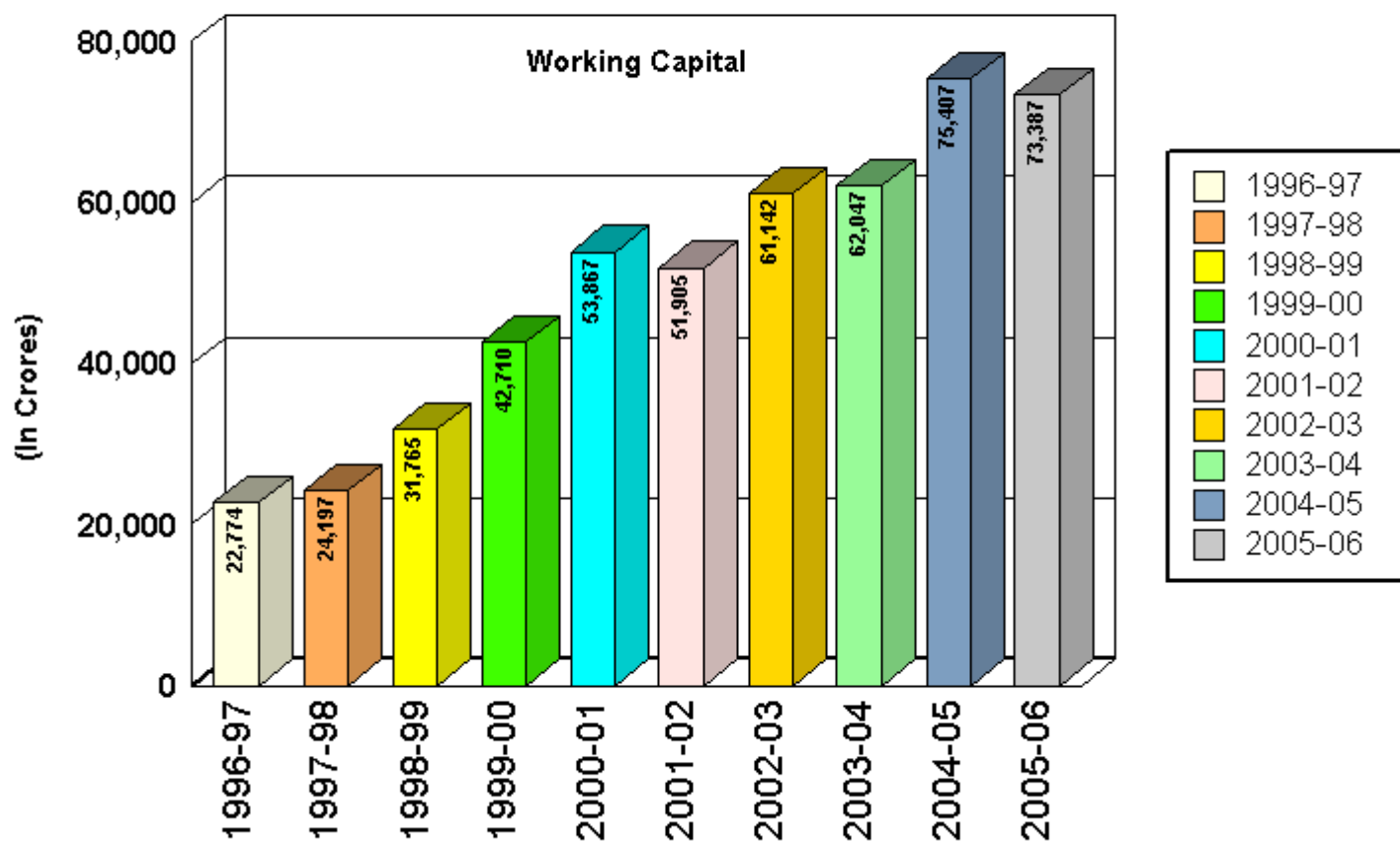
PERFORMANCE OF PRIMARY AGRICULTURAL CREDIT SOCIETIES OVER A DECADE

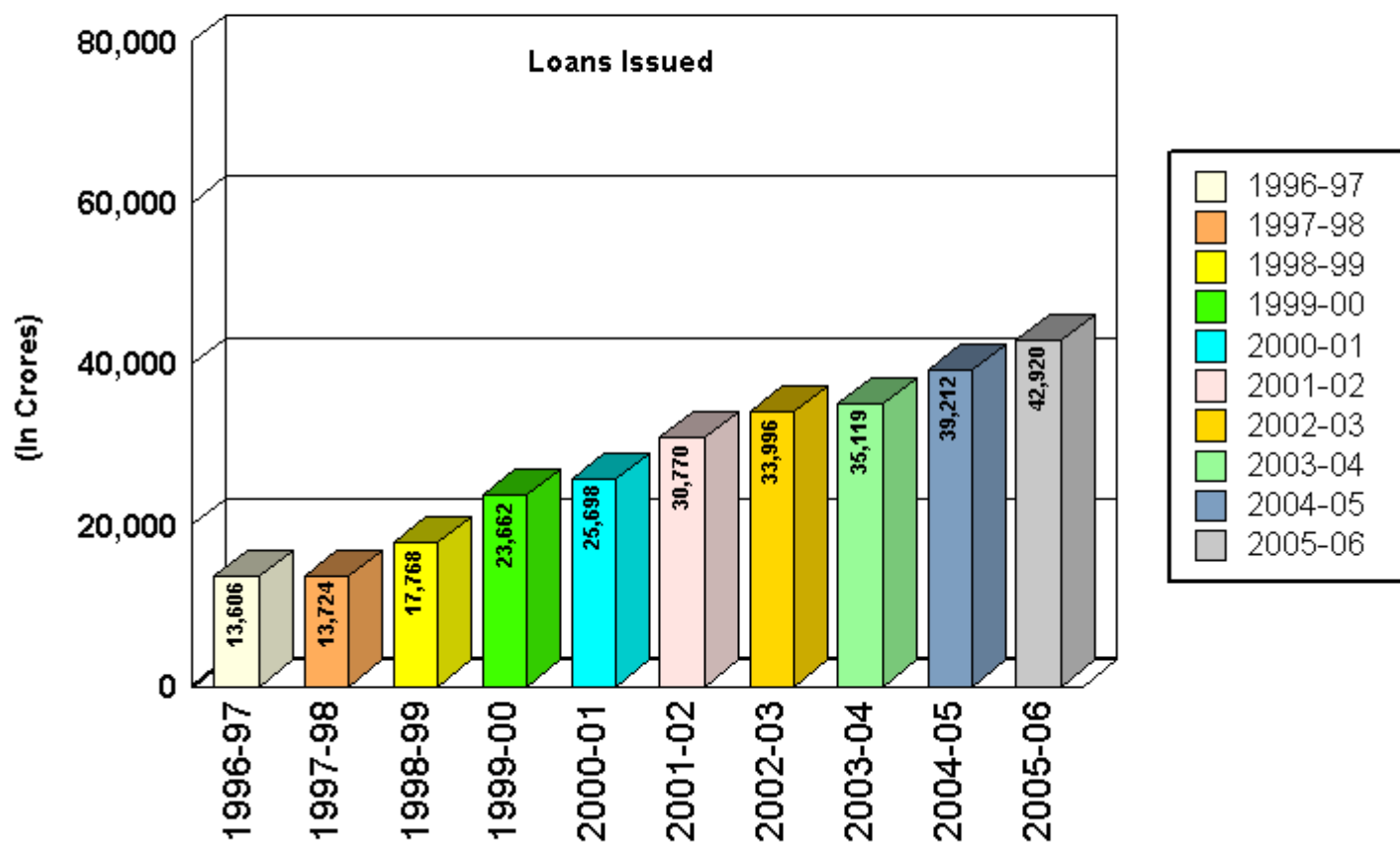

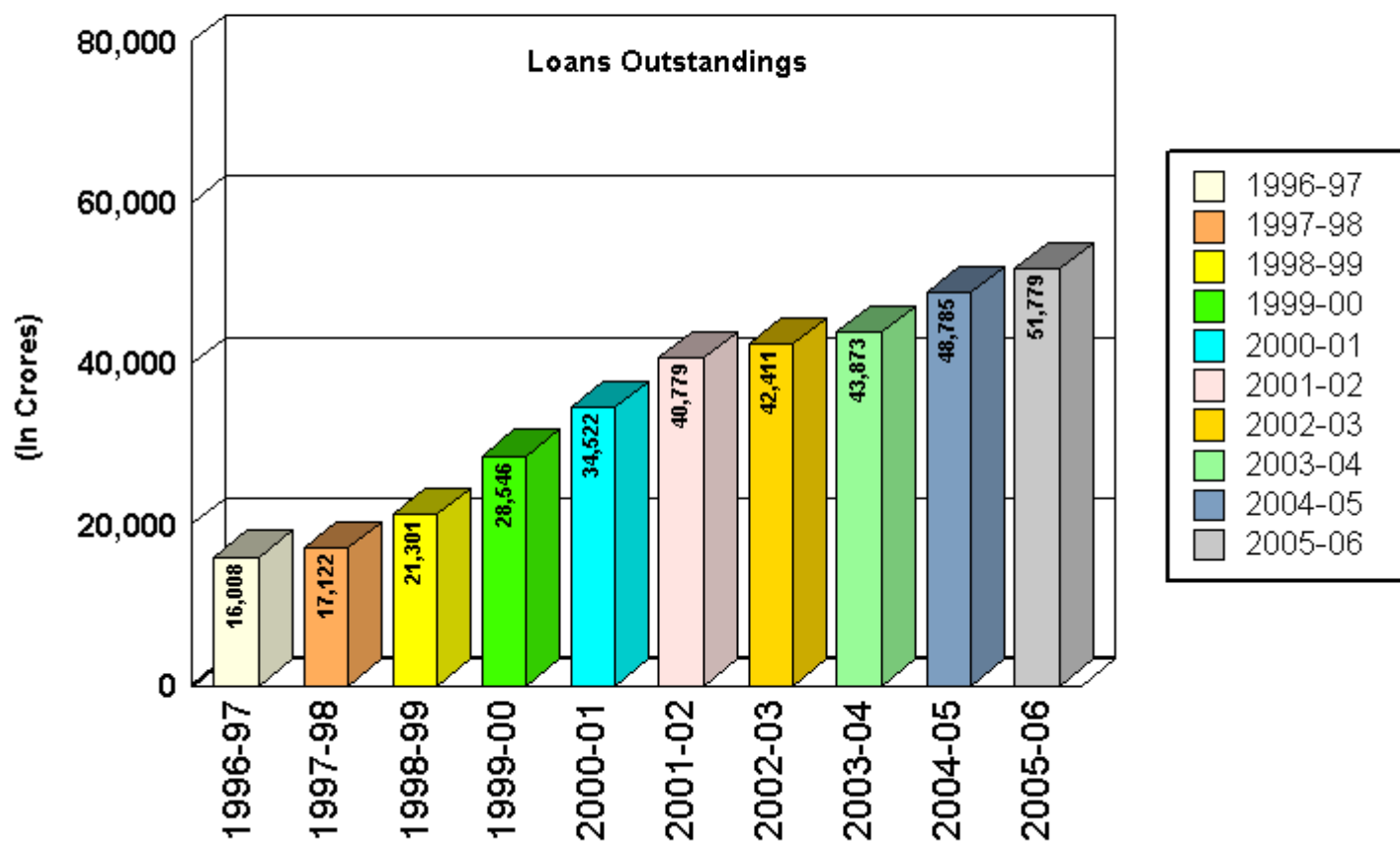

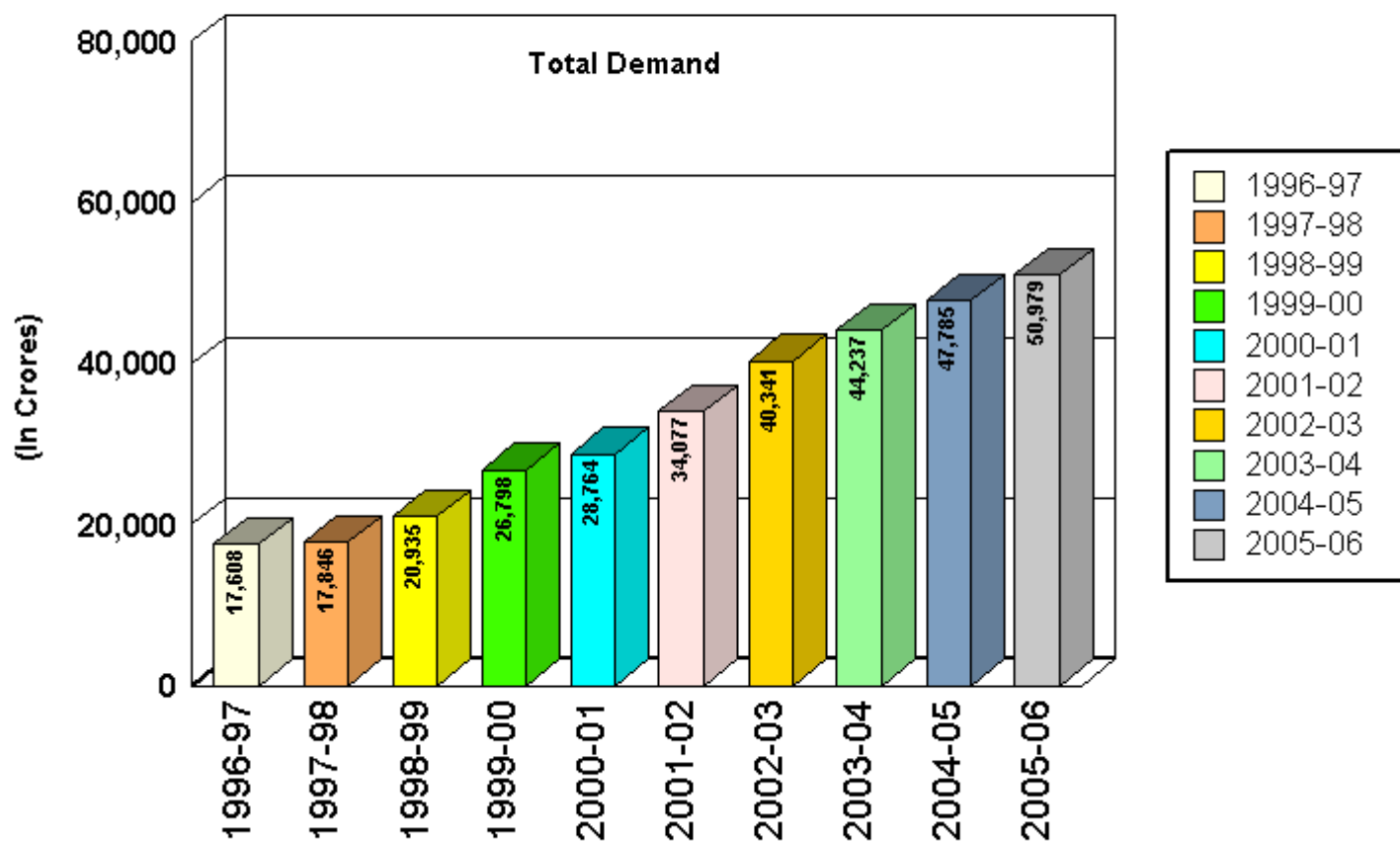

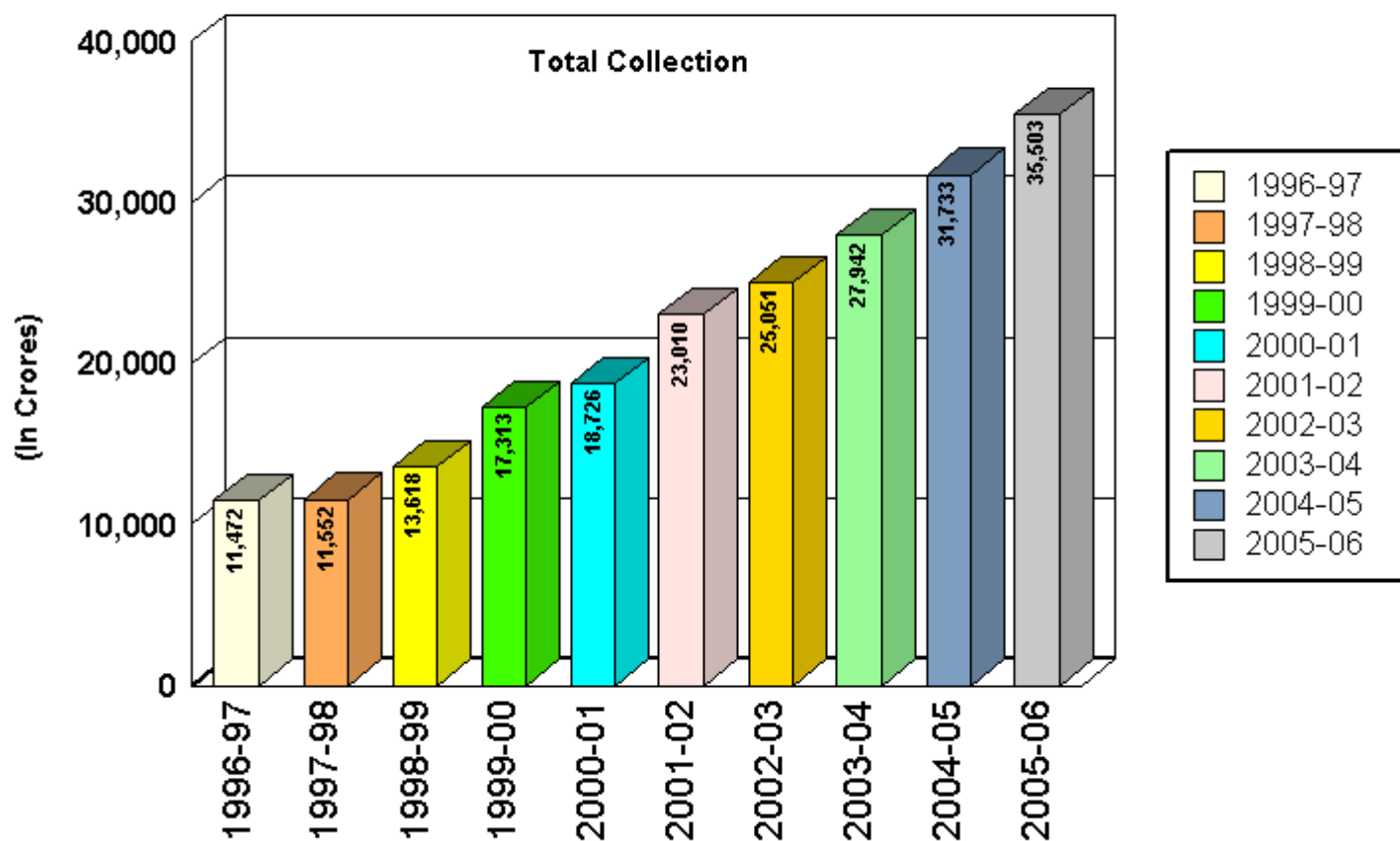
PERFORMANCE OF PRIMARY AGRICULTURAL CREDIT SOCIETIES OVER A DECADE

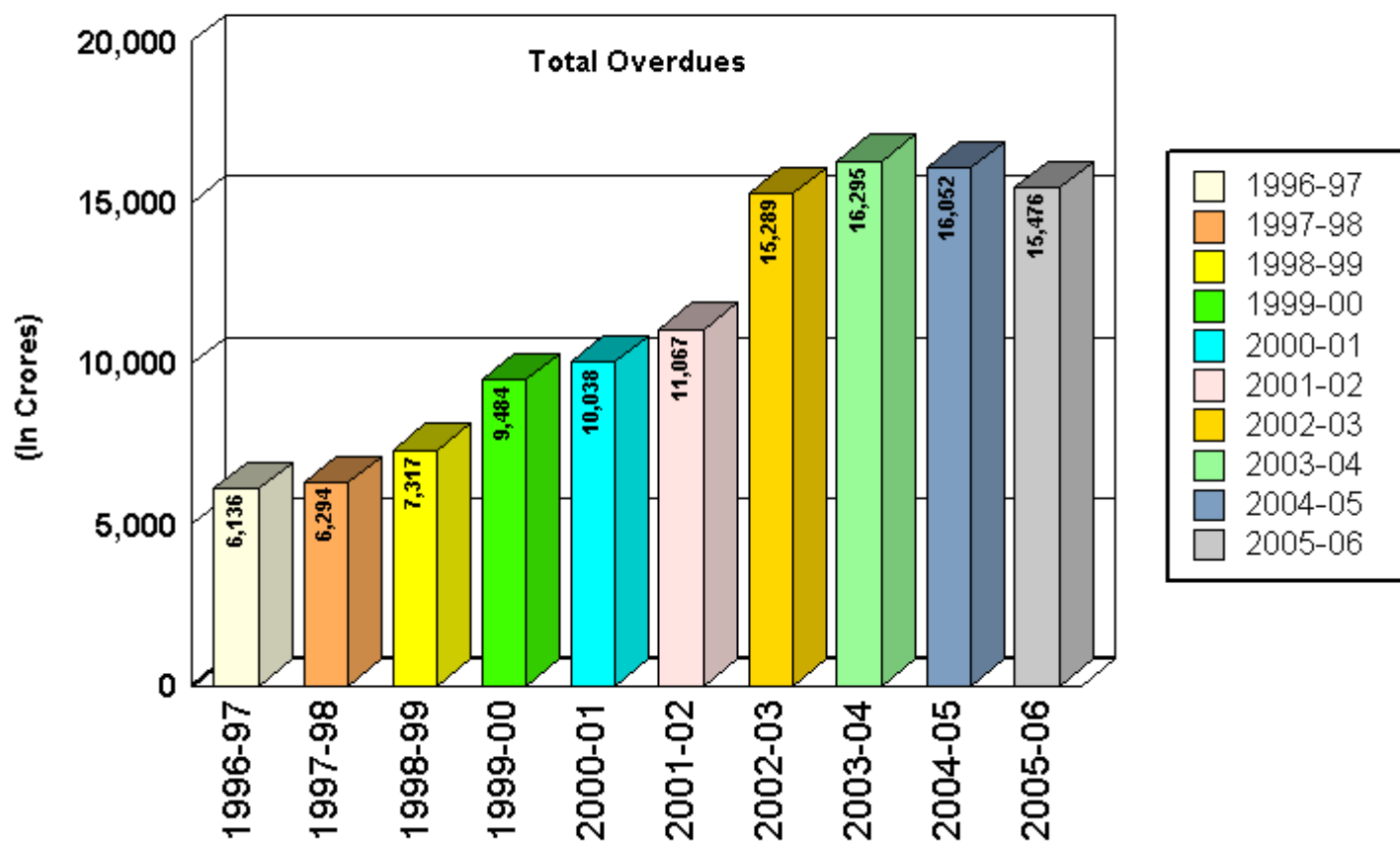

ABOUT NAFSCOB

The National Federation of State Cooperative Banks Ltd. (NAFSCOB), Mumbai was established on May 19, 1964 with a view to facilitate the operations of State and Central Cooperative Banks in general and Development of Cooperative Credit in particular .

The specific objectives of NAFSCOB are to :

- provide a common forum to the member banks to examine the problems of cooperative credit, banking and allied matters and evolve suitable strategies to deal with them.
- promote and protect the interests of the member banks in all spheres of their activities and to give expression to the views of the member banks.
- co-ordinate and liaison with Government of India, Reserve Bank of India respective State Governments, NABARD and other higher financing institutions for the development of cooperative credit on behalf of the member banks.
- provide research and consultancy inputs to the member banks in order to facilitate them to strengthen their own organisations.
- Organize conferences/seminars/workshops/meetings to share the views of common interest with a view to contribute for better policy decisions.

The Federation functions with three of its wings, viz. (1) Planning, Research and Development (PRD) (2) All India Mutual Arrangement Scheme (AIMAS) and (3) Computer Services Division (CSD) .
